SCHEDULING ORDER

1. Depositions shall be completed on or before **November 2, 2018**.
2. Discovery and disclosure of experts or rebuttal witnesses shall be completed in full on or before **December 31, 2018**.
3. A motion hearing, dispositive or non-dispositive, shall be held on **January 15, 2019 at 1:00 p.m.**
4. A Pre-Trial Conference shall be held by phone on **March 12, 2019 at 1:00 p.m.**
5. The court trial in this matter is scheduled for **March 21 and 22, 2019 beginning at 8:30 a.m.** each day in the main Courtroom on the top floor of the Jackson County Courthouse in Jackson, MN.
6. The following information shall be exchanged between parties and submitted to the Court not later than the **date and time of the Pre-Trial Conference**: list of witnesses and list of exhibits.
7. The alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process of mediation shall be used in this matter and shall be completed in full on or before **March 1, 2019**.
